▶ DISCUSSION

Davey tells about the first time he realized that his sin put Jesus on the cross. Have you come to realization? If so, you remember how/when/why you personally came to that realization?

Davey said when he was a child, he “wasn’t living his faith out loud”?

- What do you think that means?
- Are you “living your faith out loud”?
- What are ways we can live out faith out loud?

Just before Davey’s senior year of high school his family moved. Davey says that God used that move to strip away a bunch of idols in his life (sports, personal agenda, success, academics, etc.).

- What idols do you currently have in your life?
- Have you ever noticed God do something in your life to strip away such idols?
- How did you feel at the time?
- Looking back on it now, how do you feel about such idols being removed?

Davey says that the enemy’s ploy is isolation, to get us to think we are alone.

- What situations in your life do you feel isolated in?
- Has anyone else experienced the same situation? Or know someone who has?
- Have you tried to connect with others who have gone through something similar?

Davey calls God the Jujitsu artist. He says God always takes what the enemy means for evil and turns it around for good. That’s what jujitsu is, you use the opponent’s momentum against the opponent, and that’s what God does.

- Have you witnessed a situation that the enemy meant for evil but God turned it around for good?
