▶ FOCUS VERSES

The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord.

▶ DISCUSSION

- 1. Gary shares that right now he is traveling around the country in hopes to convince people that they are holy, righteous, and redeemed. If you had the same opportunity, how would you go about convincing people that God has redeemed them?**
- 2. Gary shares that he invited Jesus into his heart when he was 11 years old, but that he was about 35 years old when he truly became a Christ follower. Do you relate to this?**
- 3. Gary says that he lived his life since he was 11 years old telling people that God is good. When something horrific happened to him, he wasn't willing to take the stance all of a sudden that God isn't good anymore.**
 - Put yourself in Gary's shoes. How do you think you would have reacted if something so life changing happened to you?
 - Maybe something tragic has already happened in your life. How did you react? Do you regret any of your actions?
 - When something bad happens, do you still believe God is good? Or do you struggle?
- 4. Gary points out that his struggles are very visible. He has no arms or legs. You can physically see the struggles in his life, and people just naturally step in to help. Sometimes the scariest struggles are the invisible ones.**
 - Are you brave enough to be vulnerable? To share the invisible struggles you are going through? Or are you hesitant?
 - Gary says that as he shares his struggles, he is loved by people MORE. Have you ever had a time where you have opened up about a personal struggle and others have surrounded you in love?
