▶ FOCUS VERSE

Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, “Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all.”

▶ DISCUSSION

- 1. John talks about how the word “servant” kind of gets a bad wrap, especially with men. It is not a particularly “masculine” or “victorious” word. Why do you think that is? What are things we can do to help break that stigma?**
- 2. In what ways do you serve? Not just in your church, but in your family, your workplace, and community?**
- 3. What motivates you to serve?**
- 4. Often “serving” people want to know “what’s in it for me?”. Do you ever catch yourself thinking that question?**
- 5. John made the distinction that humility isn’t thinking less of yourself, it is thinking of yourself less often. This is a key element of demonstrating servant leadership. What are some practical, actionable ways we can think of ourselves less often?**
- 6. John talked about how God will reward those who serve others. That we don’t have to chase down our own reward. Read Colossians 3:23-24 and discuss.**
- 7. Paul and John discuss application through intentionality. What are some areas throughout your day where you might be able to serve somebody?**
