# FOCUS VERSES

### DISCUSSION

- 1. Do you have any relatives or close friends who served in the military?

  - c. How did they affect you?

  - a. Have you ever felt reluctant to talk about religion with your friends and colleagues, and if so, why?
  - b. Conversely, have you ever felt irritated or uncomfortable when a friend or co-worker talked about their faith?
  - c. Why do you think you had that reaction?
